CIMA is looking for motivated researchers to strengthen its participation to IPA DRAM Programme, that will provide technical assistance to public institutions of Western Balkans and Turkey for Disaster Risk Assessment and Mapping, in compliance with INSPIRE Directive and implementing an Electronic Regional Risk Atlas (ERRA).

The desired candidates should work pursuing the following objectives within the Programme:

- collection of geospatial data from Partner Countries and preparation for upload into ERRA IPA DRAM system;
- ordinary maintenance of the ERRA IPA DRAM platform content, control of data consistency and completeness, verification of metadata, liaison with data owner or providers;
- monitoring of ERRA IPA DRAM functionalities and tools;
- remote support to end users, proactive assistance for data upload, verification and preparation of metadata if needed;
- assistance in the identification of platform improvement based on feedbacks from end-user and Italian Civil Protection Department personnel;
- support to the design of use cases for subsequent IT development, liaison with the IT unit and testing of the functionality implemented;
- realization of manuals and reports.

The ideal candidates should have the following characteristics:

- University master's degree in civil engineering, Environmental Engineering, Environmental Sciences, Geology, Geomatics or equivalent;
- Fluency in English (written and spoken);
- Good Knowledge of GIS instruments, geospatial data collection and international regulations on geospatial data.

Further desirable assets could refer to:

- Experience in reporting;
- Excellent skills in communication and team working;
- Willingness to travel both In Italy and abroad for short term missions;
- Good knowledge of one or more languages among Serbian, Montenegrin, Bosnian, Albanian, Macedonian, Turkish.
