Different degrees are accepted, which are listed in the Call. The degree in Engineering is not the only one accepted.
4	Does the prospective assignment holder expect to travel within his respective or assigned country? from one district to another, or the selectee/local consultant needs to conduct a valid data gathering by using the needed tools, and models while still based at his/her current place of residence?	For the most part, the consultant may work from the place of residence, but may have to travel if the data gathering will require it, e.g., to meet the institutions.
